Implementation at the Federal Level

**Ministerial
Council
Decision**
(January 12, 2016)

- All Federal Ministries were tasked with the coherent implementation of the 2030 Agenda
- Mainstreaming:
 - Implementation into the day-to-day operations, if necessary, action plans and measures have to be developed
 - Involvement of all relevant stakeholders (incl. federal states)
- Working Group of all ministries chaired by the Federal Chancellery and the Federal Ministry for Europe, Integration and Foreign Affairs

- **Creating SDG-Focal-Points in all ministries**
- **Stocktaking and visualisation of the implementation process of the 2030 Agenda in Austria**

 - Performance Management Monitoring & Evaluation Tool (eWO)
