Cash and Voucher Assistance is gaining momentum, allowing for organizations to assist communities in a flexible, dignified and cost-effective manner while promoting local economy development. The course is structured around the project cycle and covers all the key skills required to design, implement, and monitor Cash and Voucher Assistance initiatives. It is focused on a technical/programmatic perspective and incorporates examples and case studies from multiple sectors. All content will be conflict-sensitive and gender-reflective and establish links to relevant policies and strategies.

The number of participants is limited to 24. Participants will be selected based on gender balance and organisational background, with preference given to humanitarian organisations.

She has been certified as a trainer for CVA Core Skill for Programme staff by CALP in the autumn of 2022
